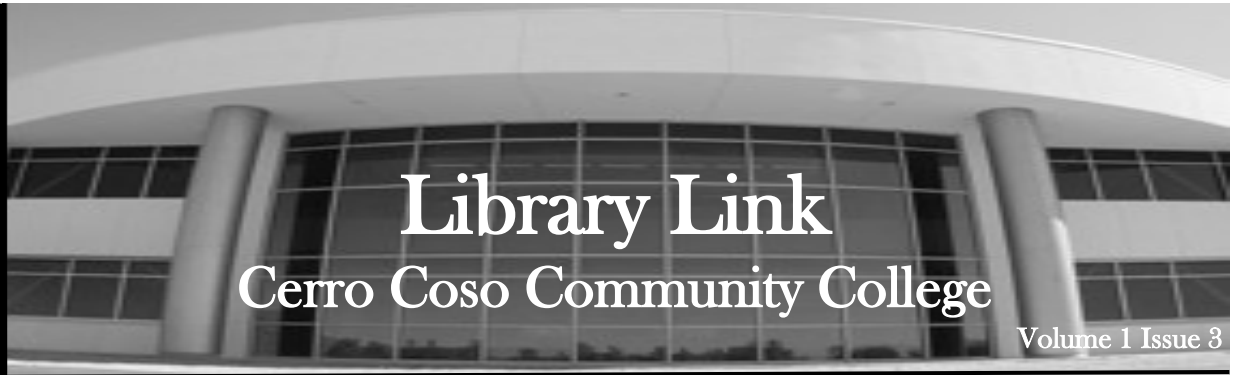

## New Databases: EBSCO!

We are transitioning to a new set of databases. Starting in the summer, we will no longer subscribe to the major Gale database suite (Academic Onefile, Expanded Academic). Instead we will have Ebsco databases including Academic Search Premiere, America History and Life, Health Source Nursing Academic, Psychology Collection, and Medline (to name just a few), which will have more full-text coverage and a more intuitive search interface. However, we will continue to subscribe to some of our favorite Gale databases like Literature Resource Center and Opposing Viewpoints Resource Center.

## LIBRARY INSTRUCTION
